The SSY Pacific Capesize Index rose by 566 points week-on-week to 8,518 points as voyage rates were supported by a combination of a busy North Atlantic market and higher bunker prices. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) jumped \$6,800/day to \$19,150/day and there was a \$1,500/day increase in the fronthaul rate to \$38,150/day.
