WEEK 40 (28th Sep to 5th Oct 2018)

Bulkers

Daebo Shipping have sold their Kamsarmax "Daebo Newcastle" 81/2011 Hyundai with DD 12/2019, to Greeks for USD 19.25 mill. Note, previous week we saw the one year older "Sky Jade" 81/2010 Universal sold at levels USD 19 mill.

JP Morgan have committed their Ultramax "Sage Baylorcom" 63/2015 Yangzhou with DD 2/2020, to Greeks clients of JME Navigation for USD 22.5 mill.

Kambara Kisen have sold their Supramax "Majulah Singapura" 58/2014 Tsuneishi Cebu to Japanese Buyers for USD 19.5 mill. Note, the "Sage Caledonia" 58/2013 Tsuneishi Cebu was sold in May for USD 18.5 mill.

Panamax "Angelic Grace" 74/2001 Hudong Shipbuilding, she was sold through auction at USD 5.5 mill rumors Only 1 bid came in.

Japanese Supramax "Medi Firenze" 58/2008 Tsuneishi Cebu, Philippines with DD 12/2018, has been sold at USD 13.3 mill to Greeks. This seems a softer price comparable with the "Tschaikowsky" 58/2018 Tsuneishi Cebu, Philippines with DD due that was sold a month ago at price of USD 14.0 mill.

Seanergy Maritime Holdings have sold their two "Guardianship" 57/2011 Jinling, for USD 12 mill and her one-year older sister "Gladiotorship" 57/2010 Jinling, for USD 11 mill.

Nova Marine have committed their Handy "Sider Boston" 30/2011 Nantong, to Greek buyers for USD 10.0 mill. Good asset placement from the Italians as they purchased the vessel in April for USD 8.8 mill.

New Yangtze Navigation have sold their heavylift MPP "Yangtze Innovation" 30/2002 Xiamen with DD 10/2019, to Chinese Buyers for USD 5.75 mill.

Tankers

Ship Finance International's latest VLCC sale has removed the "Front Ariake" 298/2001 Hitachi, sold to an unrelated third party for conversion at USD 20.7 mill.

Capital Product Partners is rumoured to have sold its oldest suezmax tanker "Amore Mio II" 160/2001 Daewoo to undisclosed buyers for USD 11.5 mill.

DRY BULK COMMENTARY

<u>Capesize</u>

Week 40 has seen West Australian iron ore into China rating mostly in the high usd 8.00's / low usd 9.00's fio range. Brazilian iron ore into China ended the week in the mid/high usd 20.00's fio range. Usd 19,000 pd for a transatlantic trip. No period activity to report here.

<u>Kamsarmax/Panamax</u>

North Pacific round trips in the usd 11,000/12,000 pd range. Pacific rounds via Indonesia in the usd 12,000/13,000 pd range. Better numbers on trips into India via Australia, primarily in the usd 14,000/15,000 pd range basis delivery at China. Usd 22,500 pd for a Baltic fronthaul. Intercontinental trips in the low/mid usd 15,000's pd range. A number of grain trips into the Red Sea from the Continent and the US Gulf have been reported in the usd 15,000/16,000 pd range basis redelivery at Gibraltar. South American fronthauls in the low/mid usd 16,000's pd range plus a usd 600,000ish ballast bonus. A number of Brazilian trips into the Continent have been reported in the usd 24,000/25,000 pd range. Usd 15,000 pd plus a usd 320,000 ballast bonus on a US trip into the Continent. Period employments in the usd 14,000/15,000 pd range.

Ultramax/Supramax

Indonesian trips into South China and India can fetch anything in the usd 13,000/15,000 pd range basis delivery in Southeast Asia. A number of South African trips into India and the Far East have been reported in the low/mid usd 13,000's pd range plus a usd 300,000ish ballast bonus. Usd 12,000 pd for a Baltic scrap into Turkey on a Supramax. Usd 16,000 pd plus a usd 650,000 ballast bonus for a South American fronthaul on an Ultramax. Usd 21,150 pd for a South American trip into Egypt on a Supramax. Usd 15,425 pd for 4/6 months on an Ultramax basis delivery in the Pacific.

Handymax / Handysize

Usd 12,000 pd for a West African trip into the Baltic. Usd 13,500 pd for a Black Sea trip into Spain. Usd 12,750 pd for a Colombian trip into Norway. No period activity to report here.
