The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index gained 246 points last week to reach a six-week high of 8,566, so maintaining a premium to the year-ago level. The Atlantic round voyage rate (180k dwt) climbed \$1,850/day to \$18,750/day, though there was a smaller decline in the fronthaul rate to \$35,000/day.
