Sharp rate increases on Tubarao-Rotterdam iron ore and Richards Bay-Rotterdam coal routes lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index 249 points higher week-on-week to an eight-week high of 8,860 points. There was a \$500/day increase in the Atlantic round-voyage rate to \$18,950/day, while the fronthaul rate slipped \$150/day to \$34,600/day.
