A slide in rates on fronthaul iron ore trades contributed to a 118-point weekly decline in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to 8,742 points. There were declines of \$950/day and \$1,450/day in the Capesize (180k dwt) fronthaul and Atlantic round-voyage rates to \$33,650/day and \$17,500/day, respectively.
