Improvements in rates on trans-Atlantic coal trades helped lift the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index 375 points week-on-week to 6,706 points, although it remains more than 2,000 points down on the end-October level. There were rises of \$2,850/day and \$1,500/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$11,500/day and \$22,000/day, respectively.
