## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

Tighter tonnage supply in the North Atlantic, prompted by vessels leaving the basin on fronthaul trades, helped drive an increase in Atlantic spot rates. The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose by 493 points to 7,389 points. The round-voyage rate (280k dwt) rose by \$2,550/day to \$16,300/day, while there was a \$5,200/day increase in the fronthaul rate to \$29,500/day.
