ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

Further gains on fronthaul iron ore routes, coupled with improvements on North Atlantic coal trades, supported a 108 point increase in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to 7,570 points, lifting it above the year-ago level. There was a \$850/day rise in the Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) to \$16,500/day, while the fronthaul rate slipped \$600/day to \$29,650/day.
