Sharp drops in spot rates on fronthaul iron ore trades contribute to a 572-point weekly decline in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to a seven-week low of 6,998 points. There were falls of \$3,000/day and \$2,000/day in the fronthaul (180k dwt) and Atlantic round-voyage rates to \$26,650/day and \$14,500/day, respectively.
