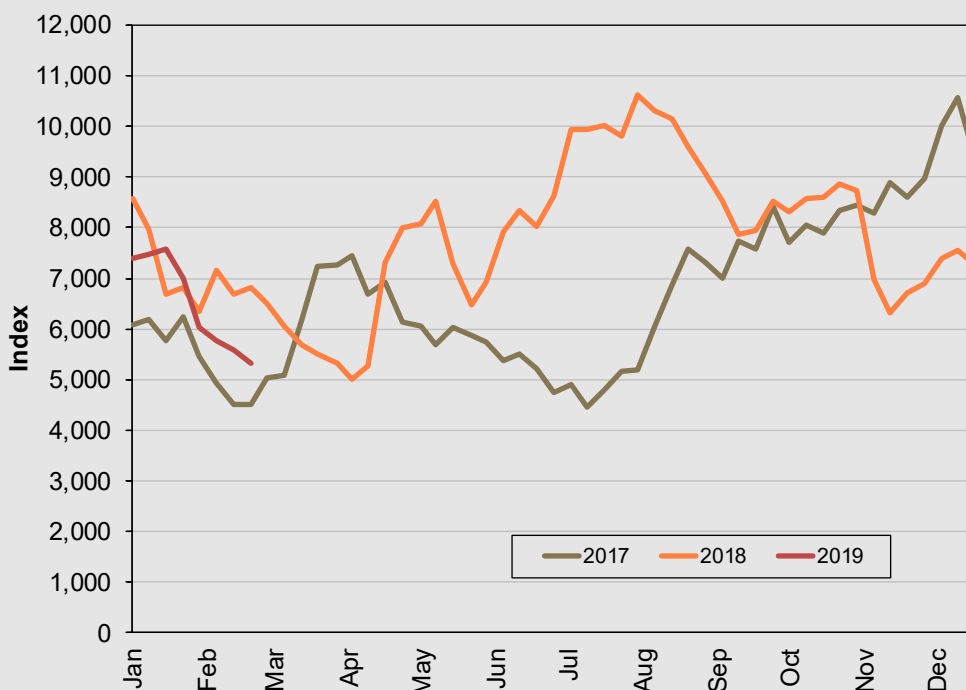
The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell 277 points last week to a ten-month low of 5,313 points. The round-voyage (180k dwt) and fronthaul rates fell \$1,650/day and \$1,850/day to \$6,350/day and \$17,650/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
