PACIFICCAPESIZE INDEX

A quiet week for both iron ore and coal chartering prompted a further 175 point weekly fall in the SSY Pacific Capesize Index. As a consequence, the index dropped below the 3,000 point mark for the first time since July 2017. There was a \$600/day decline in the Pacific round-voyage rate (180k dwt) to \$3,500/day, while the W.Australia-China iron ore spot rate was flat at \$4.85/t.
