

## ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

Last week saw a 325 point weekly drop in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to the lowest level since July 2017 at 4,723 points. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) fell by \$2,000/day to \$4,500/day, while there was a larger \$4,350/day drop in the fronthaul rate to \$12,150/day, the lowest level in more than two and a half years.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
