A softening in Atlantic coal and iron ore spot rates saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index slip 31 points lower week-on-week to 4,692 points. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) fell by \$1,300/day to the lowest level in three years at \$3,200/day, however, there was an \$850/day increase in the fronthaul rate to \$13,000/day.
