Lifted by higher earnings on trans-Atlantic coal and iron ore trades, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose by 390 points over the past week to an eleven-week high of 5,669 points. The Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) rose by \$2,000/day to \$9,000/day, while there was a \$1,150/day increase in the fronthaul rate to an eleven-week high of \$20,000/day.
