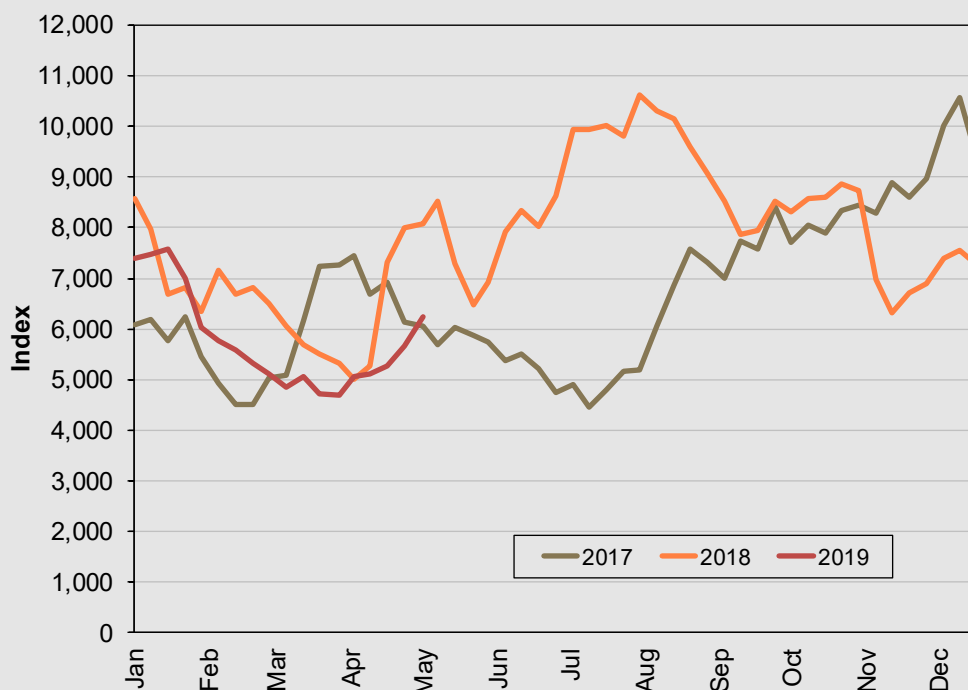
Sharp improvements in fronthaul iron ore spot rates helped lift the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index by 560 points to a 14-week high of 6,229 points. There were weekly increases of \$2,000/day and \$800/day in fronthaul and round-voyage rates (180k dwt) to \$22,000/day and \$9,800/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
