The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed a further 146 points week-on-week to the highest level since January at 6,375 points. Growth was driven by the fronthaul market, the rate (180k dwt) rising by \$3,000/day to \$25,000/day whereas there was a \$150/day drop in the round-voyage rate to \$9,650/day.
