A 154 point weekly increase lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to a 16-week high of 6,529 points. There was a \$350/day increase in the Atlantic round-voyage rate (180k dwt) to \$10,000/day, while the fronthaul rate was unchanged at \$25,000/day.
