Increases in iron ore and coal spot rates on intra-Atlantic trades lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index 242 points higher week-on-week to 6,781 points. The Atlantic round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) rose by \$1,350/day and \$2,150/day to \$11,000/day and \$26,500/day, respectively.
