A tenth consecutive weekly increase, of 219 points, lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to the highest level since January at 7,000 points. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) rose by \$2,750/day to \$29,250/day, while there was a smaller \$850/day increase in the round-voyage rate to \$11,850/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
