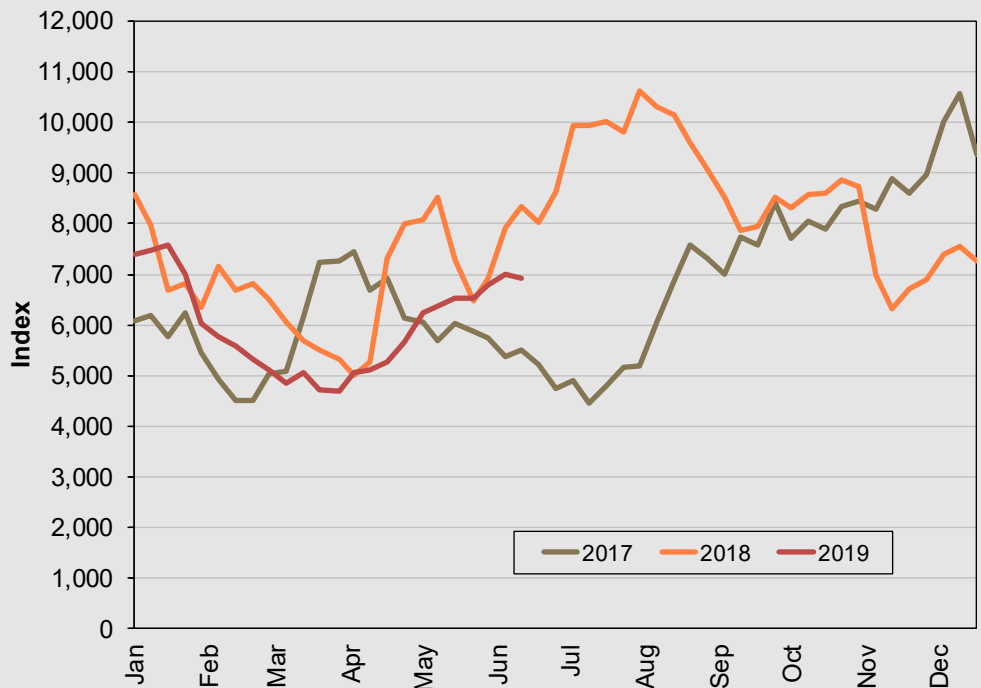
The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index slipped 80 points lower week-on-week to 6,920, more than 1,400 points below the year-ago level. There were declines of \$1,300/day and \$1,200/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$10,550/day and \$28,050/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
