A 468-point weekly increase lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index above the 10,000 point mark for the first time in almost a year to 10,407 points. It has now risen by almost 3,500 points in the past four weeks. The round-voyage rate (180k dwt) rose by \$1,100/day week-on-week to \$29,750/day, but there was a \$1,250/day drop in the fronthaul rate to \$50,750/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
