ATLANTIC CAPESIZE INDEX

A further 1,420 point weekly increase lifted the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index to the highest level in five and a half years at 11,827 points. It has now risen by close to 5,000 points during the past five weeks. There were respective weekly increases for round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt vessels) of \$3,750/day and \$7,250/day to \$33,500/day and \$58,000/day.
