ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

After five consecutive weeks of increases, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index dropped 972 points week-onweek to 10,855 points. Both round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt vessels) experienced week-on-week declines, down by \$3,500/day and \$8,000/day to \$30,000/day and \$50,000/day.
