The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 695 points last week, dropping below the 10,000 point mark for the first time in five weeks, to 9,459 points. There was a \$1,000/day decline in the fronthaul rate (basis 180k dwt) to \$44,000/day, while the round-voyage rate was unchanged at \$25,000/day.
