ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed to the highest level in over five and half years on 2 September at 11,957 points, up by 1,345 points week-on-week. There were increases of \$6,500/day and \$7,750/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$37,500/day and \$60,000/day, respectively.
