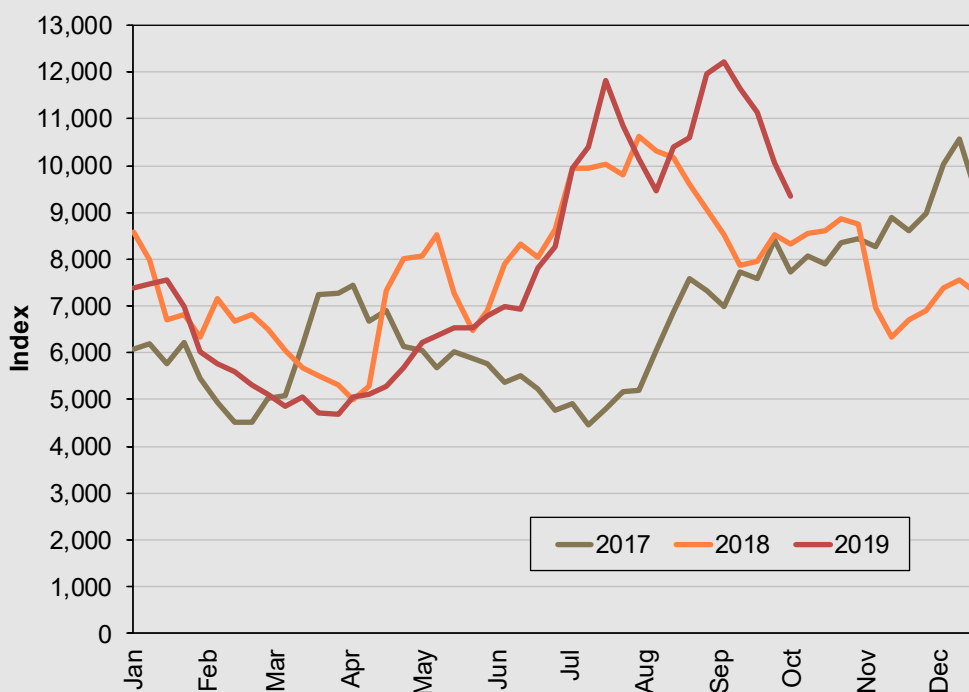
The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has dropped below the 10,000 point mark for the first time since August at 9,336 points, down by a further 734 points week-on-week. There were declines of \$4,000/day and \$1,500/day in the round -voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$22,750/day and \$48,500/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
