The SSY Pacific Capesize Index rose by 496 points week-on-week to 6,081 points and is now more than 1,900 points above the year-ago level. The W.Australia-China iron ore spot voyage rate increased by \$0.40/t to \$8.75/t, while there was a \$2,800/day increase in the round-voyage rate (180k dwt) to \$23,150/day.
