The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 416 points in the week to 25 November to 7,769 points. Round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) both fell to their lowest levels since June, dropping \$5,100/day and \$3,850/day week-on-week, to \$16,650/day and \$31,650/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
