## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

Steep declines in iron ore spot voyage rates contributed to a second consecutive weekly fall in the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index which dropped by 859 points to 8,097. There were declines of \$3,250/day and \$5,500/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$17,500/day and \$33,150/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
