PACIFICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Pacific Capesize Index fell \$537/day in the week to 23 December to reach its lowest level since early July at \$5,298/day. The W.Australia-China spot voyage rate fell \$1.15/t to \$7.20/t. Meanwhile, the round-voyage rate (180k dwt) tumbled \$8,100/day to \$11,250/day.
