The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index slipped lower over the two weeks to 6 January and begins 2020 at 7,907 points. Nevertheless, this is still 523 points higher than at the start of 2019. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) fell by \$1,850/day and \$3,400/day over the past two weeks to \$15,500/day and \$26,850/day, respectively.
