



A sixth consecutive index fall, the longest such run since the 1q19, saw the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index drop to a near seven-month low of 7,638 points. The fronthaul rate (180k dwt) retreated to \$26,000/day, while the round-voyage rate was unchanged at \$14,500/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
