The SSY Pacific Capesize Index fell to the lowest level since April 2019 at 3,982 points. The W.Australia-China rate fell \$0.70/t in the week to 27 January to \$6.15/t. Meanwhile, at \$1,750/day, the round-voyage rate (180k dwt) fell for a sixth successive week to the lowest level since the SSY Capesize Index began in May 2015.
