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The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index dropped by 240 points week-on-week to a 47-week low of 4,890 points as spot voyage rates declined across the basin. There were falls of \$750/day and \$400/day in the fronthaul and round-voyage rates (180k dwt) to \$14,500/day and \$2,250/day, respectively.
