

## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

At 4,366 points, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell to its lowest level since September 2016 on 23 March as sharp, oil price-driven, falls in bunker prices countered an increase in timecharter earnings. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) were \$6,250/day and \$16,350/day, respectively.
