PACIFICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Pacific Capesize was almost unchanged in the eight days to 14 April at 3,007 points as increases on South African routes, such as Saldanha Bay-Qingdao, cancelled out losses elsewhere. The round-voyage rate (180k dwt) fell by \$1,200/day to \$6,750/day, while there was a \$0.35/t decline in the W.Australia-Qingdao spot rate to \$4.60/t.
