The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index rose by a further 629 points in the week to 20 April to 4,997, bringing gains over the past three weeks to almost 1,000 points. There were increases of \$4,400/day and \$3,700/day in the round -voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$10,000/day and \$21,850/day, respectively.
