



After three successive weekly gains, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 489 points to 4,508. There were declines of \$2,500/day and \$700/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$7,500/day and \$21,150/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
