

PACIFICCAPESIZE INDEX

The SSY Pacific Capesize Index fell by 297 points week-on-week to 3,116, dropping back below the year-ago level. The round-voyage rate (180k dwt) declined by \$1,850/day to \$6,650/day, while the W.Australia-Qingdao spot voyage rate fell by \$0.85/t to the lowest level since August 2016 at \$4.05/t.
