



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index climbed by 333 points from 18 May to 3,304. However, it remains more than 3,200 points below the year-ago level. The fronthaul rate rose by \$3,500/day to \$14,750/day, while there was a smaller \$500/day increase in the round-voyage rate to \$1,775/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
