



At 3,228, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 76 points over the past week. The index has now fallen by more than half compared to the year-ago level. The fronthaul rate climbed \$250/day to \$15,000/day.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
