The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index jumped by 1,041 points to a six-week high of 4,269. Nevertheless, it remains 2,731 points below the year-ago level. There were increases of \$2,500/day and \$3,500/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$4,000/day and \$18,500/day, respectively.
