



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index leapt over 3,000 points higher last week to a year-to-date high of 8,666 points. It has now increased by more than 5,400 points over the past three weeks. The round-voyage rate almost tripled to \$24,000/day, while the fronthaul rate rose by \$16,250/day to \$41,000/day.

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*The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.*
