

## **ATLANTIC**CAPESIZE INDEX

At 9,068 points, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index decreased by 407 points in the week to 20 July. The round -voyage rate slipped by \$1,500/day over the past week to \$31,000/day, falling below the year-ago level. Meanwhile, the fronthaul rate declined by \$3,000/day to \$45,500/day.
