



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 314 points over the past week to the lowest level in a month at 7,414. There were declines of \$350/day and \$1,000/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$17,900/day and \$34,250/day, respectively.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
