



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 382 points over the past week to 6,619. It is now almost 3,600 points below its July peak. There were declines of \$1,250/day and \$2,000/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$13,000/day and \$31,250/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
