



The SSY Pacific Capesize Index fell by a further 181 points week-on-week to 4,428. The W.Australia-China iron ore spot voyage rate slipped \$0.15/t to \$7.00/t, while there was a \$500/day drop in the round-voyage rate to \$16,000/day.

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*The Pacific Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 27 December 1995 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.*
