The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index surged 2,152 points higher to the strongest level since September 2019 at 10,839 points. It has now risen by almost 4,000 points over the past two weeks. There were sharp increases of \$16,250/day and \$8,250/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates to \$40,000/day and \$54,500/day, respectively.
