PACIFIC CAPESIZE INDEX

A third consecutive weekly gain lifted the SSY Pacific Capesize Index 1,116 points to a near three-month high of 6,818 points. The W.Australia-China iron ore spot voyage rate rose by \$1.10/t to \$9.80/t, while there was a \$5,150/day increase in the round-voyage rate to \$29,000/day.

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The Pacific Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 27 December 1995 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
