



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index slipped 104 points lower week-on-week to 7,642. There were further declines of \$2,850/day and \$1,500/day in the round -voyage and fronthaul rates to \$19,650/day and \$32,000/day, respectively. Both are at their lowest level for five weeks.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
